# REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN BUSINESS ECONOMICS

#### **General Instructions:**

To be eligible to certify in economics, minor students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0. Minors in economics require 18 hours of economics, nine of which must be 300-400 level, with an overall GPA of at least a 2.0 in the required courses.

#### NO course for this minor may be taken on a pass/fail basis.

A total of 6 hours transfer work may be counted toward the minor requirements for courses at the 100 or 200 level only. All other course work must be taken in residence at WSU.
