## REQUIREMENTS FOR THE MINOR IN ECONOMICS

**General Instructions:**

To be eligible to certify in economics, minor students must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0. Minors in economics require 18 hours of economics, nine of which must be 300-400 level, with an overall GPA of at least a 2.0 in the required courses.

**NO course for the Econ minor may be taken on a pass/fail basis.**

A total of 6 hours transfer work may be counted toward the minor requirements for courses *at the 100 or 200 level only*. All other course work must be taken in residence at WSU. Only 3 hours of 497 or 499 may be counted as upper division electives.
